




OUR HISTORY:

First Southern Baptist Church of Westminster (FSBCW) began as a mission of First Southern, Thornton, in September 1955 following a revival by Clarence W. Garrison of Claude, Texas. The early work was supported by Southern Baptist Churches in the Texas towns of Panhandle, Broom and Claude.

In November 1955, the Mission was constituted as First Southern Baptist Church of Westminster with Howard McClure serving as pastor. A residence at 78th Avenue and Raleigh Street was converted into a church meeting place until the fall of 1957 when a new church building was completed at that site.

In November 1980, the property and building at W. 80th Avenue and Lowell Boulevard was purchased for our church. In 1987, additional education and fellowship hall construction was begun and supported through a "Faith Claiming the Mountain" Building Fund Program within the membership. Currently, members contribute to the building fund as the Lord leads them. God has used FSBCW to sponsor several missions over the years. As well, God has called several of our members to become pastors, missionaries, church music directors, etc., or to share on foreign or home mission fields.

Through both difficult times and times of fast growth, God has sustained the church. Many wonderful people have been a vital part of the work and ministry at FSBCW since it's mission beginning in 1955.

HOW TO JOIN OUR CHURCH FAMILY:

- A. By profession of faith in Jesus Christ as personal Lord and Savior, repentance of sins and subsequent scriptural baptism.
- B. By promise of a letter of recommendation from another Baptist Church of like faith and order which practices scriptural baptism in accordance with the FSBCW constitution. Candidates for church membership who come from churches of other denominations will be examined by the Pastor and/or a counselor and will be approved by consent of the Church as it relates to their testimony.
- C. By statement of prior confession of faith in Jesus Christ and scriptural baptism in a church of like faith and order.

OUR PURPOSE:

Jesus said that the foremost command of God is to, "Love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind, and all thy strength." The second, He said, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." From these we see that our first priority is to worship God and give Him His rightful place in our souls, hearts minds and bodies. We become rightly related to our Lord through personal and corporate prayer, praise, confession, and study of His word. Worship thus becomes our source

of life and ministry. From worship flows our second objective which is loving others. This includes loving both people inside the church through discipleship, mentoring, intercession, encouragement and fellowship, and outside the church via social ministries and evangelism.

OUR MISSION:

Our mission is to be involved in carrying the message of that Kingdom both home and abroad. To do this, we are involved in the Mile High Baptist Association. As an autonomous body of believers, we have chosen to work in cooperation with sister churches to support the mission causes of the Cooperative Program of the Southern Baptist Convention.
